Dear Parents,

We hope you had an enjoyable Easter break and enjoyed the rest. We are looking forward to teaching your children during their final term at Norton Community Primary School. The term is set to be a busy yet exciting one and we hope your children enjoy the challenges that they will face.

Literacy and Numeracy homework will continue to be issued on a Friday and we ask that it be returned by the following Wednesday. We were delighted with the effort that the children were putting into their reading at the end of last term and we ask for your support again, hearing your child read at least three times a week and signing appropriately in their reading record. Reading records will be checked weekly. Also your child will be given their KIRF (Key Instant Recall Facts) to practise, which is designed to improve their times tables. The KIRF sheet needs to be signed each week once your child has practised.

This term our topics will include The Vikings, Arcimboldo: An Artist Study and How to Present a Musical. PE days will be on Monday and Wednesday. We ask that your child has their summer PE kit with them which includes dark coloured shorts, a white t-shirt and a pair of trainers. Please ensure ALL kit is clearly labelled with your child's name and class. Swimming lessons will take place on Wednesday mornings starting from 25th April; all children must ensure they have appropriate clothing in order to participate.

The Key Stage Two SATs will take place the week beginning Monday 14th May 2018. It is essential that your child is in school during this week as there will be no other opportunity for them to take the tests. Please ensure that you avoid taking a family holiday in or around this very important time. During this week (Monday – Thursday) Year 6 children will have the opportunity to come in to school from 8.00am where they will be provided with breakfast.

The diary of events will be issued shortly including dates for the end of year production. We look forward to seeing as many of you at one of the performances as possible.
