

Pupil Premium 2015

The school receives £151,020 Pupil Premium funding for the financial year 2015 - 2016. This money will be used in the following ways:

To employ a Pupil Premium Co-ordinator to support learning through interventions with those pupils identified as requiring support.	£14,770
To pay for additional teachers in the most vulnerable year groups, making classes less than 24 pupils in 5 classes.	£115,442
Breakfast and After School Club is offered for free to identified vulnerable children.	£5,000
To employ a Family Support Adviser to work with families who have identified themselves as requiring support.	£31,197
Additional adults have been employed to support children who are vulnerable and not making expected progress.	£10,322
To provide fruit to all children in school at break times.	£1000
To provide milk to all children in school at break times.	£5000
To provide uniform to children in KS1 and Nursery eligible for FSM.	£1500
To support the project work of the Family Support Adviser through working with families.	£5000
