Dear Parents / Carers

Thank you so much for all the support you have given us this year. It is that time of year when we need to prepare children (and Parents) for the new classes next year. Once again may I remind you that I put a great deal of thought and consultation into the setting of new classes each year. Sometimes there are needs which require year groups to be split into different groups for the next year. This decision is not taken lightly and every piece of information is gathered about children before final classes are decided.

I will be monitoring all the classes from September and should there be any major concerns for a child not settling or making progress I will approach you to suggest possible solutions.

FS1 - Mrs Slingsby (M-W) & Miss McColgan (Th & Fri) will be in F1. Mrs Woolgar will return from maternity leave early in 2019 and take over from Miss McColgan.

FS2 - Miss Stein (Phase leader), Miss Burke, and Miss Rodgers (new in September)

#### Key Stage 1

Y1 - Miss Adamson, Miss Atkinson and Mrs Meade (Miss Dickson is getting married in the summer).

Y2 - Mrs Allington (Phase Leader), Mrs Bannister, Mrs Ralph and Miss Tyler.

#### In Key Stage 2

Year 3 - Miss Davies, Miss Leadley, Mr Merrell and Mr Stevenson.

Year 4 - Mrs Ashton (new in September), Miss Pettitt and Mrs Stephenson until Mrs Gooch returns from maternity leave at Easter. Phase leader Mrs Bates.

### **Walking buses**

To support families (who will have children at both sites) to drop off children at the start of the day, we operate a walking bus. These will leave at the following times:

- 8.30am from the Grove Street site to walk over to the Langton Road site.
- 8.40am from Langton Road site to walk over to Grove Street site.
- After School Club – 3.10pm walking bus from Langton Rd to Grove St.
