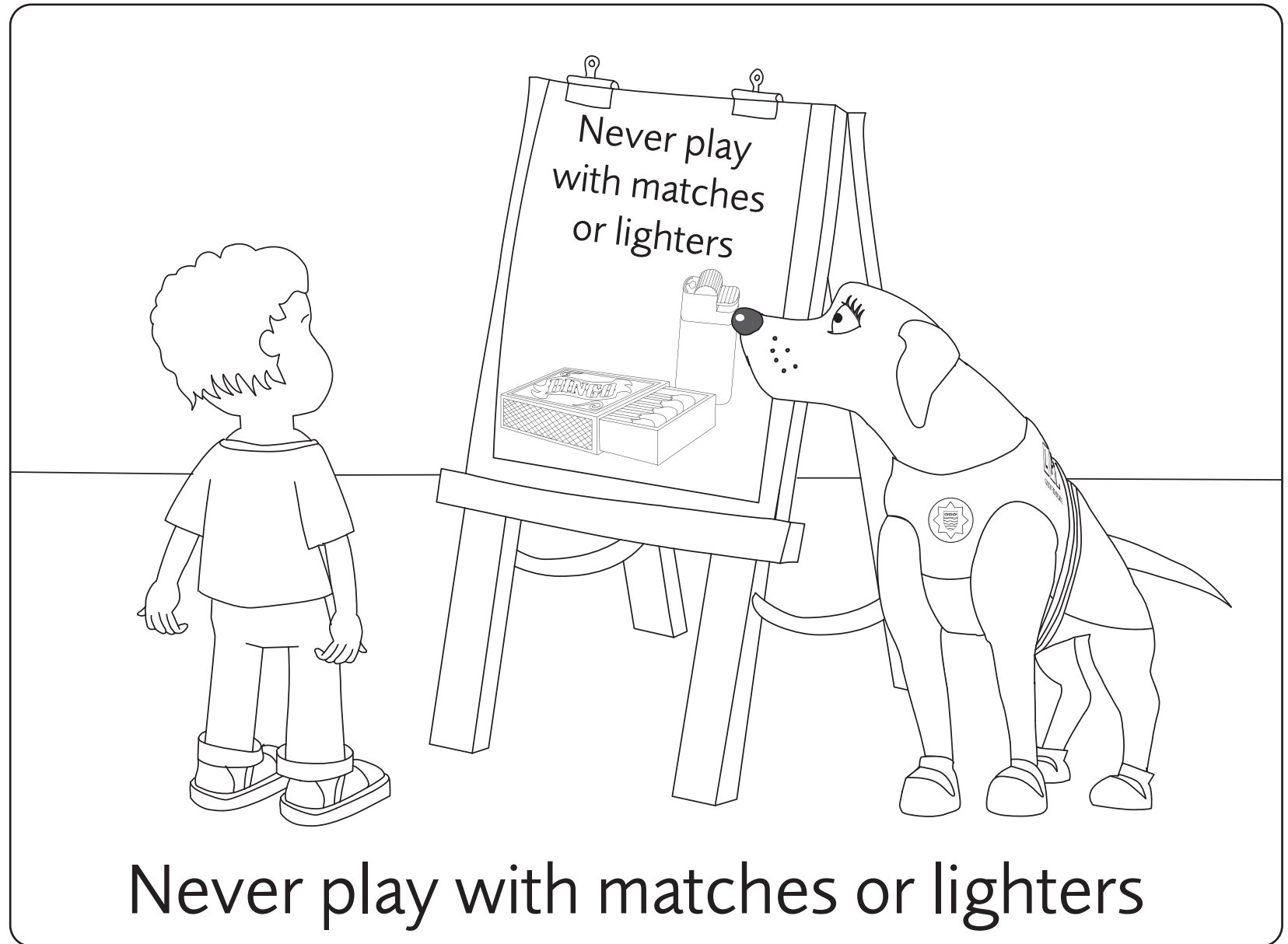

Remember, try and stay inside the lines!

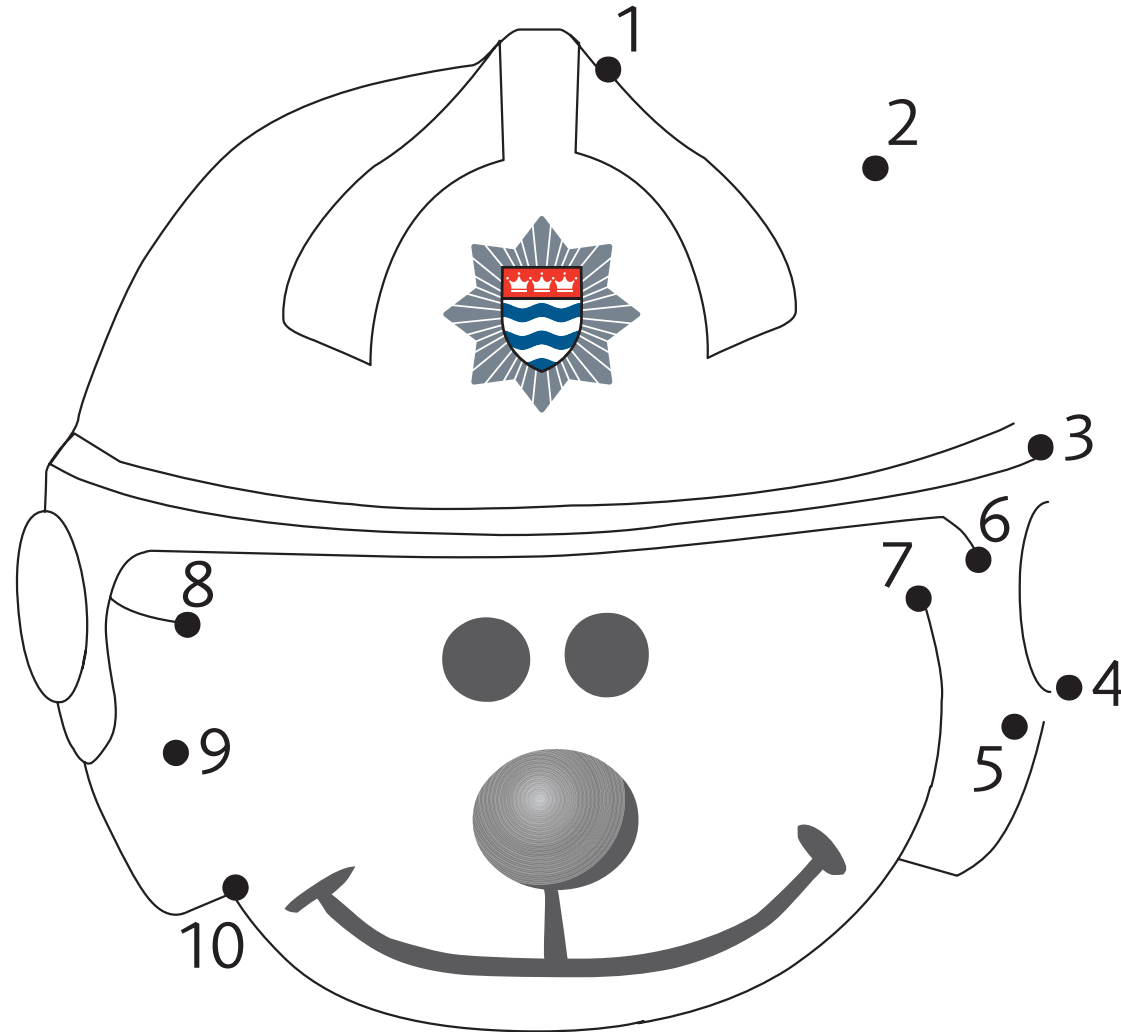


Never play with matches or lighters

Follow the numbers, starting at 1 and join the dots to make a picture of Bernie Bear, the very special fire brigade bear.

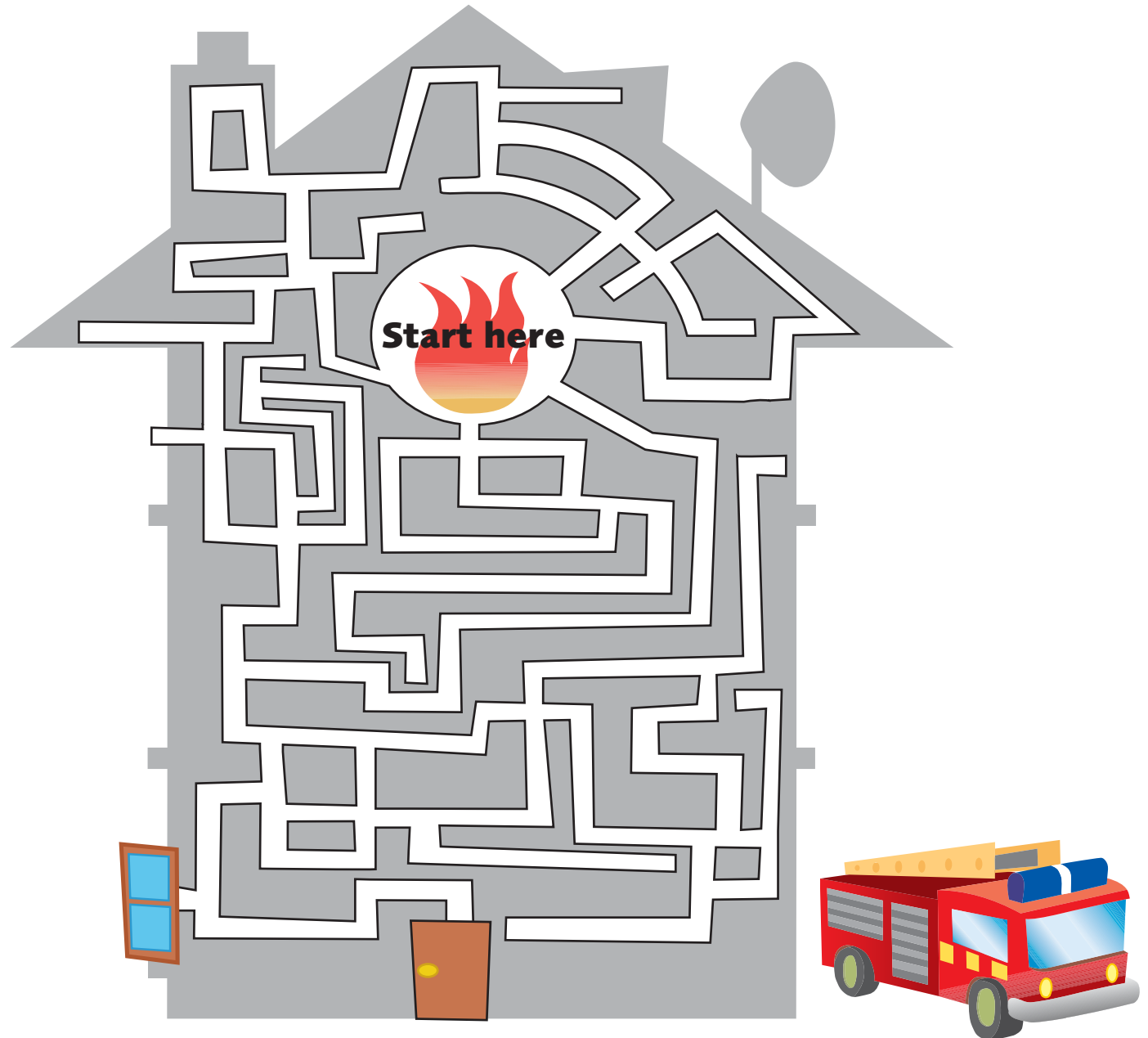
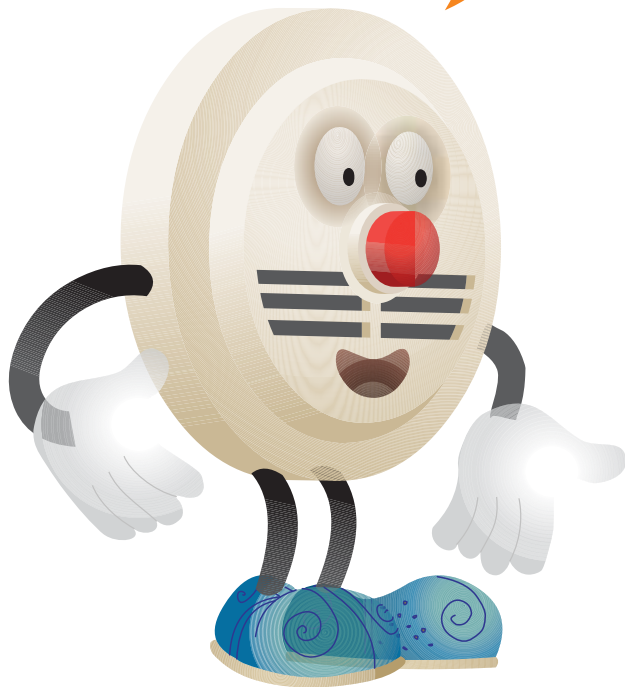

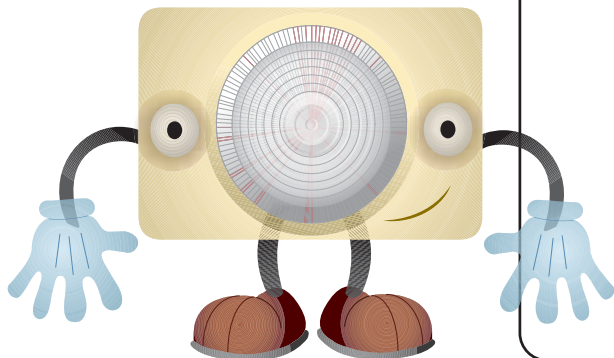
Use your felt tips, crayons or colouring pencils to colour in this picture of a family getting out of a fire.

Use your felt tips, crayons or colouring pencils to colour in this picture. It is of a very important person who helps keep us safe.

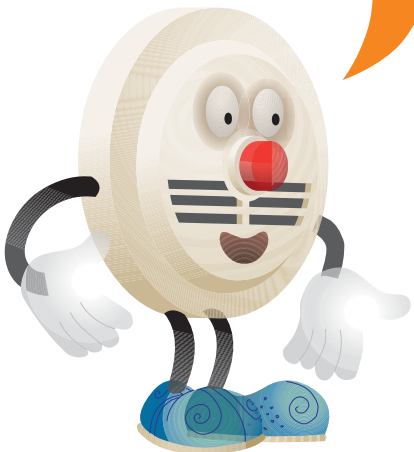

face or a sad face.

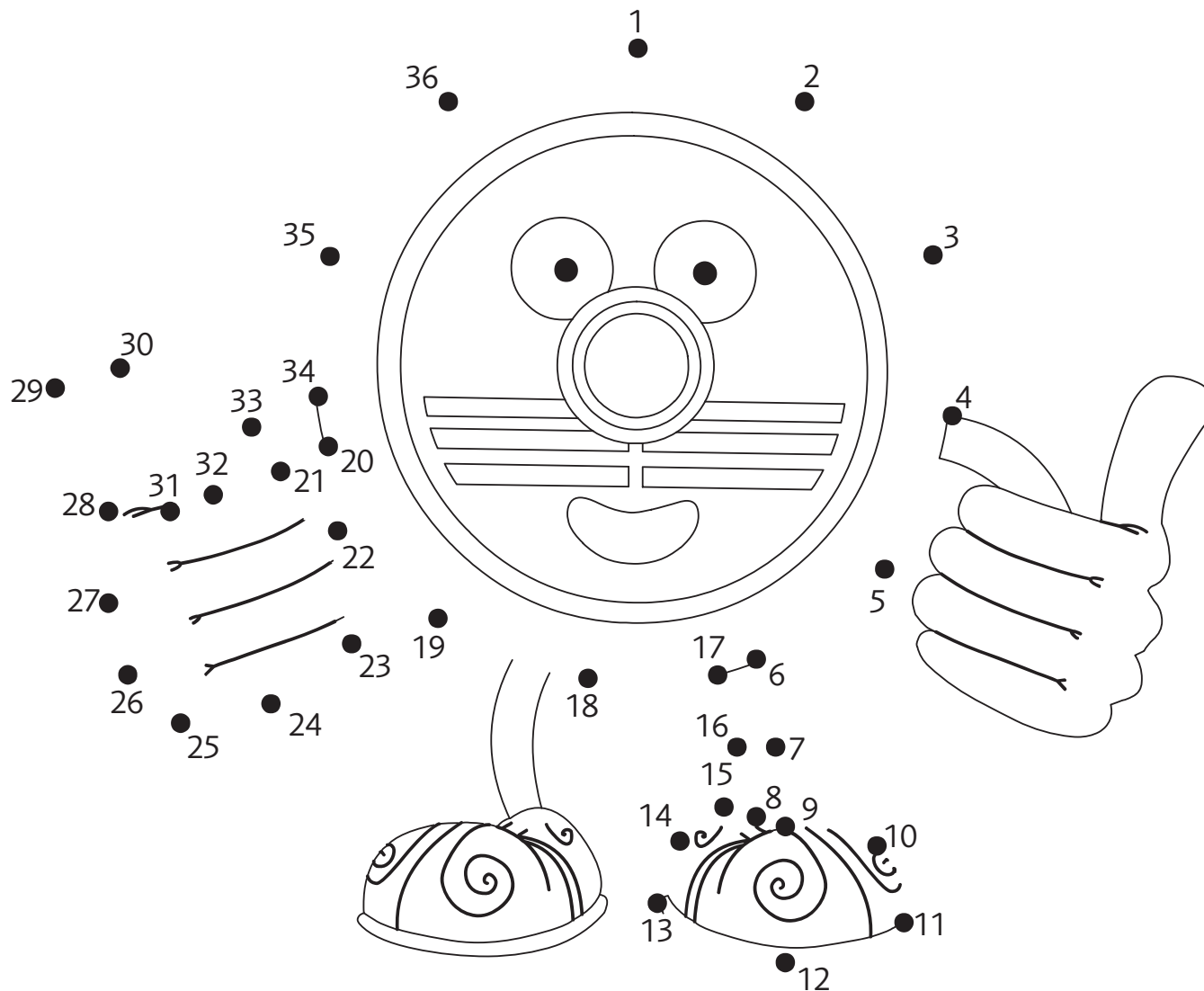
The smiley face goes

Follow the numbers starting at 1 and join the dots to make a picture of Noisy, our special friend who helps keep us safe.

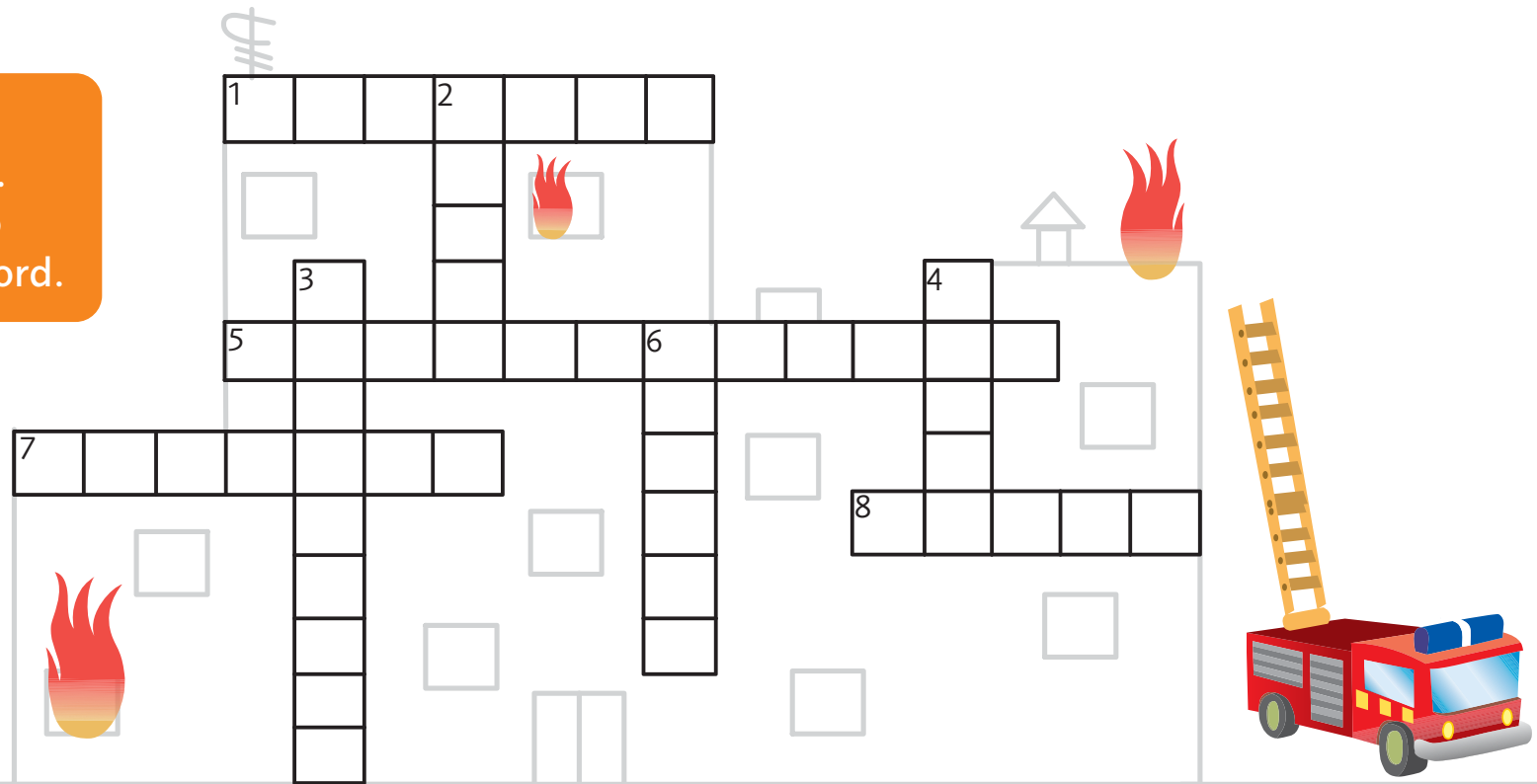

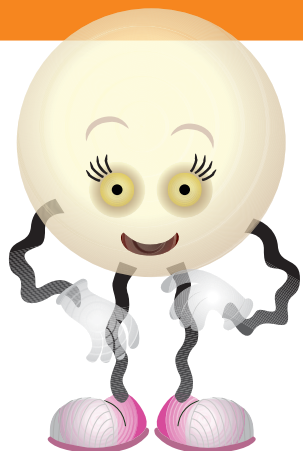

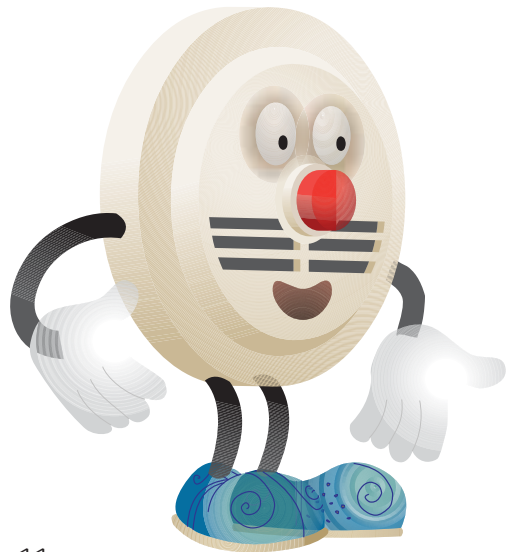


Noisy's hazard house game
