Roll the box and read the word you have written-then put it into a sentence.</p>  | <p>Today's sound: ou (shout it out)</p> <p>Watch the 'ou sound' lesson on Tapestry and join in with the rhyme.</p> <p>On Tapestry use the slides to help your child continue to learn the 'ou' sound.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you read the green words? (Pink level)</p> <p>Find a range of objects and ask your child what the initial sound is, can they write this down?</p> <p>Play bingo with the sounds-ask your child to write down 4 sounds and say different sounds and they can cross out the sounds they have.</p> |
