Dear Parent/ Carer

Thank you for your continued support in trying to keep the children and staff safe during these difficult times. We really appreciate your cooperation. As the country prepares for the second wave of the virus, we are now requesting that any adult entering the school grounds **MUST** wear a face mask as of Thursday 24th September. If you do not have a mask on, please remain outside the gates and send your children through. Either Mrs Bates or I will make sure they get to where they need to be. I am hoping that this will not be an issue for anyone and that you all appreciate the need to not allow the virus to spread into the school where we have a number of vulnerable children and adults.

Can I please remind you that the toilets outside are just for the Year 4 children. We do not expect adults to be using them. A few people have been seen using the toilets this week – please understand that for hygiene reasons these are only for the children in one year group.

Thank you to everyone who is respecting the one adult on site guidelines. There are still a number of FS parents coming in twos. Please try to remember to leave one adult outside the grounds. If you are dropping off at different doors then that is fine for one to go to one area of the school and the other to another area, but please do not stand together.

Finally, may I apologise for any confusion there has been with homework this week. We have considered all the feedback from parents so far and will make the necessary alterations. Children have been given an extension until this Friday as it is the first week. As of next week, all homework must be completed by Wednesday morning if not it will be done at lunchtime. If your child is struggling with the homework, they need to speak to the teacher on Monday to get additional help. All children need to read 3 times a week from Monday to Monday or they will stay in to read at break. Please make sure you send the homework book back into school every Wednesday even if you have done the homework online.
