	Discover	If you discover something that you did not know about before, you become aware of it or learn of it.






- What exciting things you might discover in a forest, on the beach, in the arctic, in space,

- > All children's Communication & Language skills will continue to be assessed using our WellComm screening baseline.
- > There are lots of activities to promote fine and gross motor development. We are also now practising letter formation and writing our name accuratly.
- > Miss Box will discuss with parents if she has any concerns about their child's learning and development.
- > To work closely alongside each child to develop their independence in preparation for September.

Children will Experience and Explore:

- We will be looking at atlases and maps
- ❖ We will be role playing, re-telling stories and using the puppet theatre
- ❖ We will have lots of exciting small worlds to play with
- We will explore the concepts of space and what you would find in space.
- It will be exciting to visit our new FS2 classrooms and we will discuss and practise this special transition.
- We also have our Sports Day which we are practising for.

Additionally we will be:

- Continuing to learn how to use a tripod grip, particularly when name writing
- Continuing to sound out and blend CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words, such as 'c-a-t...cat' in Phonics
- Introducing RWI, set one sounds
- Beginning to look at, create and solve simple, practical number problems
- Mark making for lots of different purposes, in lots of different contexts
- Lots of rhyming practice
- Talking about, naming and describing 2D and 3D shapes
- Learning about good oral health!

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
